

HEAVEN FEST PRAYER
From the World English Bible

Ephesians chapter 1:verses 17 through 23

[I keep praying] that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him; having the eyes of your hearts enlightened,
that you may know what is the hope of His calling,
and what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,
and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to that working of the strength of His might which He worked in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead,
and made Him to sit at His right hand in the heavenly places,
far above all rule, and authority, and power, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age, but also in that which is to come.
He put all things in subjection under His feet,
and gave Him to be head over all things for the assembly,
which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

Ephesians chapter 3:verses 14 through 21

For this cause, I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named,
that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory,
that you may be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inward man;
that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith;
to the end that you, being rooted and grounded in love,
may be strengthened to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,
and to know Christ's love which surpasses knowledge,
that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,
to Him be the glory in the assembly and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

Philippians chapter 1:verses 9through 11

This I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and all discernment;
so that you may approve the things that are excellent;
that you may be sincere and without offense to the day of Christ;
being filled with the fruits of righteousness,
which are through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

Colossians chapter 1:verses 9 through 15

For this cause, we also, since the day we heard this,
don't cease praying and making requests for you,
that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,
that you may walk worthily of the Lord, to please Him in all respects,

bearing fruit in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all power, according to the might of His glory,
for all endurance and perseverance with joy;
giving thanks to the Father, who made us fit to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light;
who delivered us out of the power of darkness,
and translated us into the Kingdom of the Son of His love;
in whom we have our redemption, the forgiveness of our sins;
who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

2 Chronicles chapter 7:verses 14 and 15

If My people, who are called by My name,
shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face,
and turn from their wicked ways;
then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin,
and will heal their land.
Now My eyes shall be open, and My ears attentive, to the prayer that is made in this place.

Matthew chapter 6:verses 9 and 10

Pray like this:
‘Our Father in heaven,
may Your name be kept holy.
Let Your Kingdom come.
Let Your will be done, as in heaven, so on earth.

Zephaniah chapter 3: verses 12 and 13

But I will leave in the midst of you an afflicted and poor people,
and they will take refuge in the name of Yahweh.
The remnant of Israel will not do iniquity, nor speak lies,
neither will a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth,
for they will feed and lie down,
and no one will make them afraid.”

Amos chapter 9: verses 11 through 15

In that day I will raise up the tent of David who is fallen,
and close up its breaches, and I will raise up its ruins,
and I will build it as in the days of old;
that they may possess the remnant of Edom,
and all the nations who are called by My name,” says Yahweh who does this.
“Behold, the days come,” says Yahweh,
“that the plowman shall overtake the reaper,
and the one treading grapes, him who sows seed;
and sweet wine will drip from the mountains,
and flow from the hills.
I will bring My people Israel back from captivity,
and they will rebuild the ruined cities, and inhabit them;
and they will plant vineyards, and drink wine from them.
They shall also make gardens,
and eat their fruit.
I will plant them on their land,

and they will no more be plucked up out of their land which I have given them,” says Yahweh your God.

John chapter 16: verse 8

[Jesus said], “When [the Holy Spirit] has come, He will convict the world about sin, about righteousness, and about judgment.”

Matthew chapter 3: verse 11

[John said], “I indeed baptize you in water for repentance, but He who comes after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you in the Holy Spirit and fire.”

Mark chapter 16: verse 20

They went out, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word by the signs that followed. Amen.

Isaiah chapter 56: verses 4 and 5

For thus says Yahweh, “To the eunuchs who keep My Sabbaths, and choose the things that please Me, and hold fast My covenant: to them I will give in My house and within My walls a memorial and a name better than of sons and of daughters; I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off.

Isaiah chapter 56: verses 6 and 7

Also the foreigners who join themselves to Yahweh, to minister to Him, and to love the name of Yahweh, to be His servants, everyone who keeps the Sabbath from profaning it, and holds fast My covenant; even them will I bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted on My altar; for My house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples.”

Proverbs chapter 21: verse 22

A wise man scales the city of the mighty, and brings down the strength of its confidence.

2 Chronicles chapter 5: verses 11 through 14

It happened, when the priests had come out of the holy place, (for all the priests who were present had sanctified themselves, and didn't keep their divisions; also the Levites who were the singers, all of them, even Asaph, Heman, Jeduthun, and their sons and their brothers, arrayed in fine linen, with cymbals and stringed instruments and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them 120 priests sounding with trumpets;) it happened, when the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking Yahweh; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised Yahweh, saying, “For He is good;

for His loving kindness endures forever!”
that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of Yahweh,
so that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud:
for the glory of Yahweh filled the house of God.

2 Chronicles chapter 29: verse 11

My sons, don't be negligent now;
for Yahweh has chosen you to stand before Him,
to minister to Him,
and that you should be His ministers, and burn incense.”

John chapter 17: verse 3

This is eternal life, that they should know You, the only true God,
and Him whom You sent, Jesus Christ.

Psalms chapter 19

The heavens declare the glory of God.
The expanse shows His handiwork.
Day after day they pour forth speech,
and night after night they display knowledge.
There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard.
Their voice has gone out through all the earth,
their words to the end of the world.
In them He has set a tent for the sun, which is as a bridegroom coming out of his room,
like a strong man rejoicing to run his course.
His going forth is from the end of the heavens, His circuit to its ends;
There is nothing hidden from its heat.
Yahweh's law is perfect, restoring the soul.
Yahweh's testimony is sure, making wise the simple.
Yahweh's precepts are right, rejoicing the heart.
Yahweh's commandment is pure, enlightening the eyes.
The fear of Yahweh is clean, enduring forever.
Yahweh's ordinances are true, and righteous altogether.
More to be desired are they than gold, yes, than much fine gold;
sweeter also than honey and the extract of the honeycomb.
Moreover by them is Your servant warned.
In keeping them there is great reward.
Who can discern his errors?
Forgive me from hidden errors.
Keep back Your servant also from presumptuous sins.
Let them not have dominion over me.
Then I will be upright.
I will be blameless and innocent of great transgression.
Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight,
Yahweh, my Rock, and my Redeemer.

Isaiah chapter 60: verses 1 through 5

“Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of Yahweh is risen on you.
For, behold, darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the peoples; but Yahweh
will arise on you, and His glory shall be seen on you.
Nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.

“Lift up your eyes all around, and see: they all gather themselves together, they come to you;
your sons shall come from far, and your daughters shall be carried in the arms.
Then you shall see and be radiant, and your heart shall thrill and be enlarged; because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you, the wealth of the nations shall come to you.

Isaiah chapter 62: verses 2 through 7

The nations shall see your righteousness, and all kings your glory,
and you shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of Yahweh shall name.
You shall also be a crown of beauty in the hand of Yahweh,
and a royal diadem in the hand of your God.
You shall no more be termed Forsaken;
neither shall your land any more be termed Desolate:
for Yahweh delights in you, and your land shall be married.
For as a young man marries a virgin, so your sons shall marry you;
and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride,
so your God will rejoice over you.
I have set watchmen on your walls, Jerusalem;
they shall never hold their peace day nor night:
you who call on Yahweh, take no rest, and give Him no rest,
until He establishes, and until He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

Acts chapter 4: verse 31

When they had prayed,
the place was shaken where they were gathered together.
They were all filled with the Holy Spirit,
and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Psalms chapter 138: verses 5 through 8

Yes, they will sing of the ways of Yahweh;
for great is Yahweh's glory.
For though Yahweh is high, yet He looks after the lowly;
but the proud, He knows from afar.
Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me.
You will stretch forth Your hand against the wrath of my enemies.
Your right hand will save me.
Yahweh will fulfill that which concerns me;
Your loving kindness, Yahweh, endures forever.
Don't forsake the works of Your own hands.

Psalms chapter 80: verses 17 through 19

Let Your hand be on the man of Your right hand,
on the son of man whom You made strong for Yourself.
So we will not turn away from You.
Revive us, and we will call on Your name.
Turn us again, Yahweh God of Armies.
Cause Your face to shine, and we will be saved.

Psalm chapter 85

Yahweh, You have been favorable to Your land.
You have restored the fortunes of Jacob.
You have forgiven the iniquity of Your people.
You have covered all their sin.
Selah.
You have taken away all Your wrath.
You have turned from the fierceness of Your anger.
Turn us, God of our salvation,
and cause Your indignation toward us to cease.
Will You be angry with us forever?
Will You draw out Your anger to all generations?
Won't You revive us again,
that Your people may rejoice in You?
Show us Your loving kindness, Yahweh.
Grant us Your salvation.
I will hear what God, Yahweh, will speak,
for He will speak peace to His people, His saints;
but let them not turn again to folly.
Surely His salvation is near those who fear Him,
that glory may dwell in our land.
Mercy and truth meet together.
Righteousness and peace have kissed each other.
Truth springs out of the earth.
Righteousness has looked down from heaven.
Yes, Yahweh will give that which is good.
Our land will yield its increase.
Righteousness goes before Him,
And prepares the way for His steps.

Psalm chapter 51:verses 1 through 17

Have mercy on me, God, according to Your loving kindness.
According to the multitude of Your tender mercies, blot out my transgressions.
Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity.
Cleanse me from my sin.
For I know my transgressions.
My sin is constantly before me.
Against You, and You only, have I sinned,
and done that which is evil in Your sight;
that You may be proved right when You speak, and justified when You judge.
Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity.
In sin my mother conceived me.
Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts.
You teach me wisdom in the inmost place.
Purify me with hyssop, and I will be clean.
Wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.
Let me hear joy and gladness,
That the bones which You have broken may rejoice.
Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all of my iniquities.
Create in me a clean heart, O God.
Renew a right spirit within me.

Don't throw me from Your presence,
and don't take Your holy Spirit from me.
Restore to me the joy of Your salvation.
Uphold me with a willing spirit.
Then I will teach transgressors Your ways.
Sinners shall be converted to You.
Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, the God of my salvation.
My tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness.
Lord, open my lips.
My mouth shall declare Your praise.
For You don't delight in sacrifice, or else I would give it.
You have no pleasure in burnt offering.
The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit.
A broken and contrite heart, O God, You will not despise.

Psalm chapter 118: verses 22 through 24

The stone which the builders rejected has become the head of the corner.
This is Yahweh's doing.
It is marvelous in our eyes.
This is the day that Yahweh has made.
We will rejoice and be glad in it!

Isaiah chapter 55: verses 1 through 3

"Come, everyone who thirsts, to the waters!
Come, he who has no money, buy, and eat!
Yes, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.
Why do you spend money for that which is not bread?
and your labor for that which doesn't satisfy?
listen diligently to Me, and eat you that which is good, and let your soul delight itself in
fatness.
Turn your ear, and come to Me; hear, and your soul shall live:
and I will make an everlasting covenant with you,
even the sure mercies of David.

Isaiah chapter 55: verses 6 through 13

Seek Yahweh while He may be found; call you on Him while He is near:
let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts;
and let him return to Yahweh, and He will have mercy on him;
and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.
"For My thoughts are not your thoughts,
neither are your ways My ways," says Yahweh.
"For as the heavens are higher than the earth,
so are My ways higher than your ways,
and My thoughts than your thoughts.
For as the rain comes down and the snow from the sky,
and doesn't return there, but waters the earth,
and makes it bring forth and bud,
and gives seed to the sower and bread to the eater;
so shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth:
it shall not return to Me void,
but it shall accomplish that which I please,

and it shall prosper in the thing I sent it to do.
For you shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace:
the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing;
and all the trees of the fields shall clap their hands.
Instead of the thorn shall come up the fir tree;
and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree:
and it shall be to Yahweh for a Name,
for an everlasting sign that shall not be cut off.”

Isaiah chapter 57: verse 15

For thus says the high and lofty One who inhabits eternity,
whose name is Holy:
“I dwell in the high and holy place,
with him also who is of a contrite and humble spirit,
to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite.

Isaiah chapter 64: verses 1 through 5

Oh that You would tear the heavens, that You would come down,
that the mountains might quake at Your presence,
as when fire kindles the brushwood, and the fire causes the waters to boil;
to make Your name known to Your adversaries,
that the nations may tremble at Your presence!
When You did awesome things which we didn't look for, You came down,
the mountains quaked at Your presence.
For from of old men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither has the eye seen a
God besides You, who works for him who waits for Him.
You meet him who rejoices and works righteousness,
those who remember You in Your ways.
Behold, You were angry, and we sinned.
We have been in sin for a long time; and shall we be saved?

Habakkuk chapter 3: verse 2

Yahweh, I have heard of Your fame.
I stand in awe of Your deeds, Yahweh.
Renew Your work in the midst of the years.
In the midst of the years make it known.
In wrath, You remember mercy.

Zephaniah chapter 1: verse 7

Be silent at the presence of the Lord Yahweh,
for the day of Yahweh is at hand.
For Yahweh has prepared a sacrifice.
He has consecrated His guests.

Exodus chapter 33:verses 18 and 19

[Moses] said, “Please show me Your glory.”
[The Lord] said, “I will make all My goodness pass before you,
and will proclaim the name of Yahweh before you.
I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious,
and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy.”

Joel chapter 2: verses 28 and 29

“It will happen afterward, that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh;
and your sons and your daughters will prophesy.
Your old men will dream dreams.
Your young men will see visions.
And also on the servants and on the handmaids in those days,
I will pour out My Spirit.

Joel chapter 2: verses 12 through 19

“Yet even now,” says Yahweh, “turn to Me with all your heart,
and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning.”
Tear your heart, and not your garments,
and turn to Yahweh, your God;
for He is gracious and merciful,
slow to anger, and abundant in loving kindness,
and relents from sending calamity.
Who knows? He may turn and relent,
and leave a blessing behind Him,
even a meal offering and a drink offering to Yahweh, your God.
Blow the trumpet in Zion!
Sanctify a fast.
Call a solemn assembly.
Gather the people.
Sanctify the assembly.
Assemble the elders.
Gather the children, and those who nurse from breasts.
Let the bridegroom go forth from his room,
and the bride out of her room.
Let the priests, the ministers of Yahweh,
weep between the porch and the altar,
and let them say, “Spare Your people, Yahweh,
and don’t give Your heritage to reproach,
that the nations should rule over them.
Why should they say among the peoples,
‘Where is their God?’”
Then Yahweh was jealous for His land,
And had pity on His people.
Yahweh answered His people,
“Behold, I will send you grain, new wine, and oil,
and you will be satisfied with them;
and I will no more make you a reproach among the nations.

Psalm chapter 145: verses 4 through 7

One generation will commend Your works to another,
and will declare Your mighty acts.
Of the glorious majesty of Your honor,
of Your wondrous works, I will meditate.
Men will speak of the might of Your awesome acts.
I will declare Your greatness.
They will utter the memory of Your great goodness,
and will sing of Your righteousness.

Psalm chapter 145:verses 10 through 13

All Your works will give thanks to You, Yahweh.
Your saints will extol You.
They will speak of the glory of Your kingdom,
and talk about Your power;
to make known to the sons of men His mighty acts,
the glory of the majesty of His kingdom.
Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom.
Your dominion endures throughout all generations.
Yahweh is faithful in all His words,
and loving in all His deeds.

2 Peter chapter 3: verse 9

The Lord is not slow concerning His promise, as some count slowness;
but is patient with us, not wishing that any should perish,
but that all should come to repentance.

Psalm chapter 22: verses 28 through 31

For the kingdom is Yahweh's.
He is the ruler over the nations.
All the rich ones of the earth shall eat and worship.
All those who go down to the dust shall bow before Him,
even he who can't keep his soul alive.
Posterity shall serve him.
Future generations shall be told about the Lord.
They shall come and shall declare His righteousness to a people that shall be born, for He
has done it.

Jonah chapter 3: verses 1 and 2

The word of Yahweh came to Jonah the second time, saying,
“Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city,
and preach to it the message that I give you.”

2 Corinthians chapter 5:verses 18 through 21

But all things are of God, who reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and gave to
us the ministry of reconciliation;
namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself,
not reckoning to them their trespasses,
and having committed to us the word of reconciliation.
We are therefore ambassadors on behalf of Christ,
as though God were entreating by us:
we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.
For Him who knew no sin, He made to be sin on our behalf;
so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.

John chapter 3:verse 16

For God so loved the world, that He gave His one and only Son,
that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.

John chapter 15:verse 16

[Jesus said], “You didn't choose Me, but I chose you,

and appointed you, that you should go and bear fruit,
and that your fruit should remain;
that whatever you will ask of the Father in My name, He may give it to you.”

Ps. 121

I lift up my eyes to the hills—
where does my help come from?
My help comes from the LORD,
the Maker of heaven and earth.
He will not let your foot slip—
He who watches over you will not slumber;
indeed, He who watches over Israel
